Second Scripture Lesson: **John 3:14-21**  
Just as Moses lifted up the snake in the wilderness, so the Son of Man must be lifted up, that everyone who believes may have eternal life in him. For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but to save the world through him.
